

Public Comments on Round One

Constructive criticism of fiscal terms, regulatory framework and model contract

It is to invite unnecessary doubts about the sincerity of the government's interest in receiving public comments about Round One if the web portal window is named merely "*sugerencias*." The complex topics require analysis and structured arguments that go far beyond any matter of a "suggestion."

The web portal should explicitly offer a place for stakeholder feedback from the public and private sectors. A mechanism to upload documents should be offered (as illustrated below).

The invitation to submit comments should be at least bilingual, in English and Spanish (but other languages would be easy to include).

If you leave this submission form as it is, you will not get the response that authorities tell audiences that they want. The strong impression will be that "suggestions" will be received by the IT Department and never reach the desk of anyone in CNH, SENER, SHCP or OPM (Office of the President).
